Devotional Note from Pastor Steve

Matthew 8:23-27 (NIV)

Then he got into the boat and his disciples followed him. Suddenly a furious storm came up on the lake, so that the waves swept over the boat. But Jesus was sleeping. The disciples went and woke him, saying, "Lord, save us! We're going to drown!"

He replied, "You of little faith, why are you so afraid?" Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm.

The men were amazed and asked, "What kind of man is this? Even the winds and the waves obey him!"

In this world we are facing a time that none of us have experienced. We are in the midst of a storm. A storm that is washing over our world. One where everything feels furiously attacking our normal way of life. The disciples lived with Jesus and still found themselves in the storm. We think sometimes that if we follow Jesus the storm will not come, but it is here now. We like the disciples are going to feel like all hope is lost until we turn to Jesus for our salvation and strength. Jesus stopped the wind and waves, now this does not mean we pray and the virus will disappear. Jesus himself did not run away from the suffering of the cross, He embraced it. However, Jesus was with his disciples in the midst of the storm. He told His disciples it was better for Him to leave so the Counselor would come. You are not alone.
